This year, chefs are to prepare any dish that is most representative our theme, *“Celebrating the Soul of the South”*, for our guest to sample. The event will be held on Saturday, February 3, 2024, at the Two Mississippi Museums. Two awards will be presented: *“Top Bash Chef”* and *“People’s Choice Award”*.

For the second year of this event, Sous Chefs will also be able to compete for the *“Top Sous Chef”* Award. They are to create an hors d’oeuvre which best showcases their talents. The same judging criteria will apply. The winning Sous Chef then qualifies to compete in the *“Top Bash Chef”* competition in 2025.
